# **Emergency Preparedness Update**

Over the past few years, a tremendous amount of work has gone into preparing to keep John Stubbs' students and staff safe in the event of an emergency. There is a secure shipping container in the teacher parking lot containing emergency food, water and supplies. There are currently enough high calorie, long shelf life energy bars to sustain the school population for just over one full day but the goal is to have enough for 72 hours (three days), as recommended by the provincial government. The City of Colwood recommends four days.

It is at this time we are asking parents to send in \$7 per student so that we can purchase sufficient food. In the past we have asked parents to send food, but these emergency bars are a much easier option. Please send \$7 to classroom teachers with your child by Thursday, February 19<sup>th</sup>. Cheques payable to John Stubbs PAC. Thank you.
