

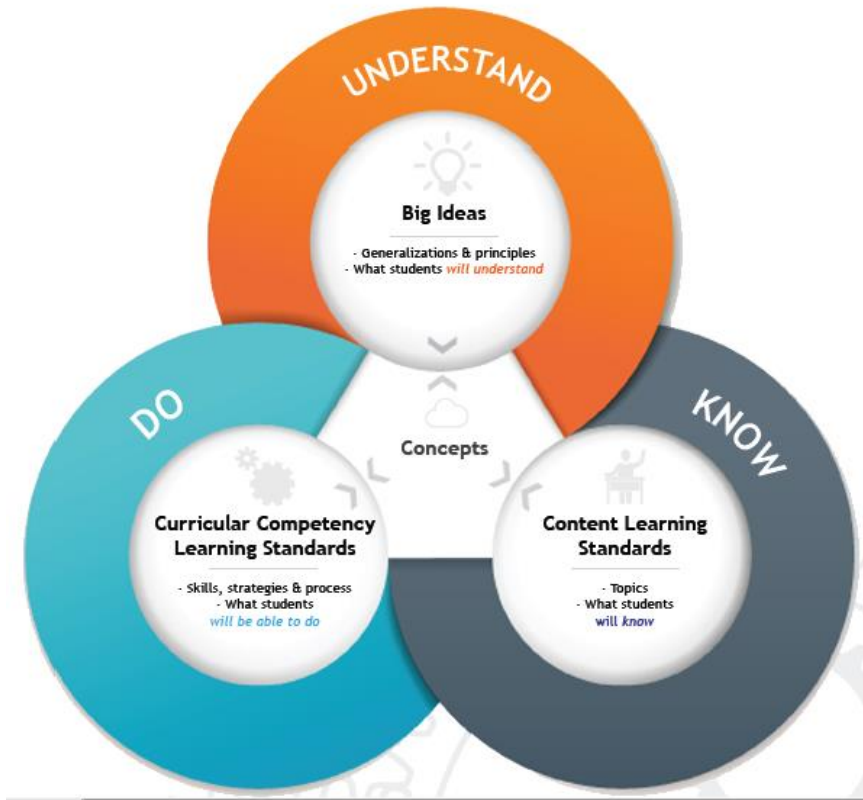
## BC'S REDESIGNED CURRICULUM
